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CHAPTER – I

Organisation of the Department & its Functions

1.1 Rules of Business:

Department of Public Enterprises (DPE) has been incorporated on 4th January 1991 to oversee and regulate the functioning of the State Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs). The Department of Public Enterprises is headed by a Cabinet Minister and the Secretariat is headed by a Principal Secretary to the Government of Odisha who is assisted by three Additional Secretaries, two Joint Secretaries, Deputy Director, and AFA-Cum-Deputy Director, three Under Secretaries and other Ministerial Staff and others. It is the 'Nodal Department' for the State PSUs with total staff strength of 39 against the sanctioned strength of 56 and through is one of the leanest Departments of the Government. Yet it has been supervising the functioning of the State PSUs as a referral and Nodal Department effectively.

Odisha State Renewal Fund Society (OSRFS):- The Odisha State Renewal Fund Society (OSRFS) a Society registered under Societies Registration Act 1860 was set up in 2009-10. Its initial period was for five years from 2009-10 to 2013-14. After completion of the project period the proposal for extension of the terms of OSRFS from 2014 to 02.12.2019 and 03.12.2019 to 31.03.2024 with budgetary provision of Rs.63.00 crore and 50.00 crore respectively.

The Principal Secretary, DPE is functioning as the Chairman of OSRFS and assisted by the Additional Secretaries as Member Secretary and AFA-cum-Deputy Director as its Accounts Officer.

The following activities are entrusted to this Department as per the Rules of Business.

1. Laying down general policy and guidelines for effective management, marketing, finance and services etc. of Public Sector Undertakings and periodic review of their performance.
2. Regulating Industrial Project Proposals through the Project Approval Committee.
3. Prescribing norms for financial discipline, budgeting, accounting and audit in the Public Sector Undertakings.
4. Eliciting information and data from Public Sector Undertakings and advising on preventive measures against their becoming sick.

5. Prescribing norms for mutual co-operation and co-ordination among the Public Sector Undertakings.
6. Prescribing Model Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) and reviewing the progress of MoUs.

Additional Responsibilities

1. Implementation of decisions of the Government relating to sale/ privatization/ divestment of the identified State PSUs and Co-operative Enterprises.
2. Assistance to State PSUs including Co-operative Enterprises in implementing their VR Scheme.
3. This Department is implementing and overseeing the Public Enterprise Reform Programme of the Government through OSRFS and implementing for the voluntarily retired / separated employees of the State PSUs.
4. Selection of Professionals for the top Managerial Posts like Directors including Managing Directors for the PSUs of the State through Public Enterprises Selection Board (PESB) when requested by the concerned PSUs/ Board through their Administrative Department.
5. Implementation of Corporate Governance Manual for State PSUs for their smooth functioning.

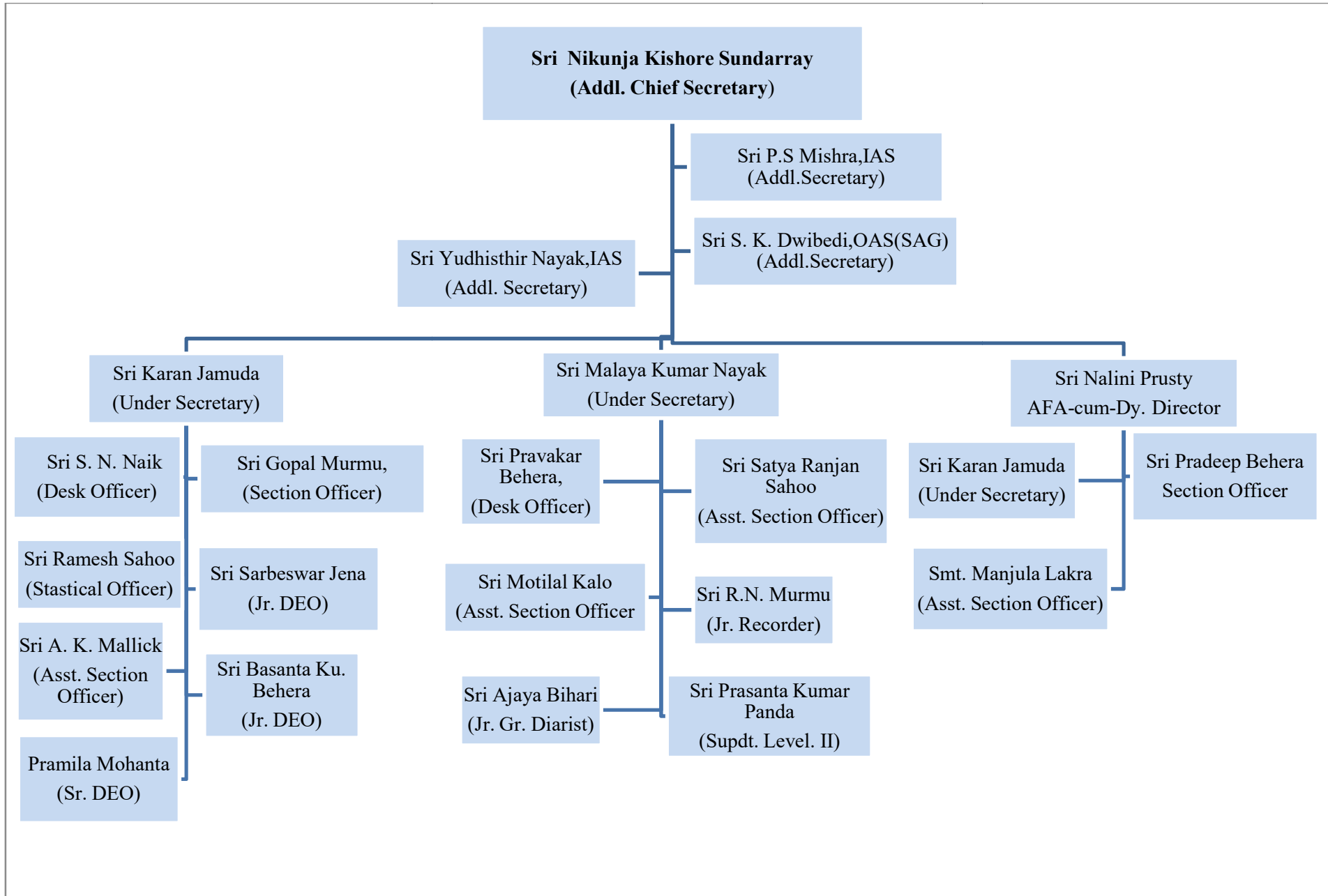
1.2 Management of the Department:

The Department of Public Enterprises oversees the functions of the State Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) and advises on their efficient management and control in the functional areas, such as finance, production, organization and marketing.

The Department has been using computer systems in its office operation. In order to broaden the system NIC NET connection has been installed in the Department through NIC (ER), Bhubaneswar.

1.3 Budget Allocation

Government of Odisha have allocated required funds to this Department under two heads of expenditure, viz. 3451-Secretariat Economic Services (Non-Plan) and 2235-Social Security & Welfare –(State Plan) .

DPE is providing financial assistance through OSRFS to the State PSUs including Co-operative Enterprises to implement Voluntary Retirement Scheme at their end as per the approved VR Schemes of the Government.

CHAPTER –II

Performance of the Department of Public Enterprises

Department of Public Enterprises, being the Nodal Department for the State PSUs, has discharged its activities as per the Rules of Business. The major activities during the FY 2021-22 were as follows:

2.1-- Finalization of Audit & Accounts

Government of India, successive Finance Commissions and statutory authorities are emphasizing for timely compilation and finalization of audit of accounts of State PSUs. Keeping in view of their concerns, DPE has instructed the Chief Executives and senior officials of the PSUs to Complete the arrear accounts of the working PSUs within a definite time frame.

2.2 -- Approval of Project Investment Proposal

Capital investment decisions are very crucial on the part of the State PSUs as well as Government. Government in DPE has framed policy to monitor the investment proposals of the State PSUs and beyond a threshold limit and the same is placed before the Project Approval Committee (PAC) headed by the Chief Secretary, Odisha. Two meeting of the Project Approval Committee (PAC) have been held during 2020-21.

2.3 Disbursement of financial assistance to the State PSUs and Cooperative Enterprises for implementation of VRS

VRS payment during 2021-22.

- VRS assistance amounting to Rs. 17,95,61,990/- has been paid in favour of 295 nos. employees different PSUs during OSRFS Phase-II i:e 2014 to 2018-19.
- Arrear dues amounting to Rs.4,03,00,000/- has also been released in favour of MD SPINFED for disbursement in favour of 6813 nos. of employees of 5(five) sick cooperative Spinning Mills as per orders of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in SLP No. (c) 354-355 of 2009.

- VRS assistance amounting to Rs.61,14,838.00/- has been paid to the 3nos.Ex-employees of IDCOL Ferrochrome and Alloys Ltd. (IFCAL) during the year 2021-22.through Odisha State Renewal Fund Society (OSRFS).
- VRS assistance amounting to Rs.14,29,277.00/- has been paid to the 1nos. Ex-employee of Odisha Pisciculture Development Corporation Ltd. (OPDC) during the year i: e2021-22. through Odisha State Renewal Fund Society (OSRFS).

2.4. Issue of Circulars / Office Memorandum / Resolutions

In line with the activities envisaged in the Rules of Business, the Department has issued number of Resolutions on various issues from time to time. Details of the circulars, guidelines, Office Memorandums and Resolutions issued during FY 2021-22 are at Annexure- A , B, C , D & E.

2.5 Corporate Governance Manual for the State PSUs.

Corporate governance is system by which companies are directed and managed. It elucidates the processes for setting up and achieving the objectives of the organization, maximizing performance and minimizing risk. Good corporate governance practices enable organizations to create value, improve accountability and develop internal controls to safeguard the integrity of their business processes.

Given the special role of the State Public Sector Undertaking (PSUs) in achieving the developmental and infrastructure goals, proper systems of governance assume importance. The need to improve accountability in the PSUs, while ensuring that they meet the stated objectives, has given impetus to the adoption of good governance practices.

2.6 Re assessment of categorization of State PSUs.

The categorizations of State PSUs are being undertaken in this Department since 2011-12. Out of 36 State PSUs there are Four PSUs under Gold Category, Seven PSUs under silvers Category and Five PSUs under Bronze category at present. Action has been taken up by this Department for reassessment of their performances for their categorization.

CHAPTER –III

Performance of the PSUs

Public sector is an essential and vibrant element in building-up of India's economy. Public Enterprises have played an important role in achieving the objective of economic growth with social justice. The State Government, in order to fulfill the objectives, has set-up public enterprises to harness local resources of the State and thereby to create employment opportunities. They have been working for the development of the State in many ways. However, the State Government is making an endeavor to offer quality service to the people through the Public Sector Enterprises. The State Government, in the recent past devised a system of Memorandum of Understanding to monitor and measure performance among State PSUs.

The Public Sector Undertakings (PSUs) consist of state Government Companies and Statutory Corporations. The state PSUs are established to carry out activities of commercial nature keeping in view the welfare of the people of Odisha. The working state PSUs registered a turnover of Rs.47617.69 Crore and earned a profit of Rs.2068.814 Crore in aggregate during 2021-22 as per their latest finalized accounts.

As on 31st March 2022, there were 64 PSUs as per the details given below.

3.1 Investment

As on 31st March 2022, the investment (paid up capital and loans) in 36 PSUs is Rs.48260.3 Crore (paid up Capital Rs9447.4 Crore and loan Rs. 38812.9 Crore).

3.2 Profit & Loss

Out of 36 working PSUs, 25 PSUs have earned profit, 10 PSUs have sustained loss and Odisha State Civil Supplies Corporation Ltd. is running on no Profit and no Loss basis. The PSUs earning profit/ incurring loss during the financial year 2021-22 are follows.

CHAPTER-IV

Odisha Public Enterprise Reform Programme.

4.1 Back ground: The Government of Odisha initiated Public Enterprises Reform in mid-1999 with technical and financial assistance from DFID. A “White Paper on Public Enterprise Reform” was presented before the Odisha Legislative Assembly in April 2002, highlighting the need for reforms in Public Enterprises. DFID supported two phases of reform and the second phase concluded in 2008.

The first two phases of the program focused on:-

- Achieving fiscal sustainability by containing outflow of the State’s budgetary resources in the non-performing Public Enterprises.
- Right sizing of organizations through VRS/VSS.
- Devise reform strategy for PSUs and Co-operative Enterprises and identify entities for reform, closure and privatization.
- Financial assistance for skill up gradation of separated employees through Social Safety Net Programme (SSNP) to provide alternative means of livelihood.

4.2 ODISHA STATE RENEWAL FUND SOCIETY (OSRFS)

(a) Back ground

Considering the benefits of the reform and to continue the ongoing programmes, the State Government was pleased to set up the Odisha State Renewal Fund Society (OSRFS) under the Administrative Control of Public Enterprise Department with fund support from State Government Budget and DFID.

(b) Objectives

The broad objectives of the Odisha State Renewal Fund Society (OSRFS) include the following:-

- i. Assist DPE in planning, implementing & monitoring the PSU reforms programme.
- ii. Build on benefits already achieved in phases I & II of OPERP.
- iii. Support Government of Odisha initiative for adoption of corporate governance measures & practices in all State PSUs.
- iv. Ensure continuation of the Social Safety Net Programme (SSNP) so that the reforms programmes do not lose its human face.
- v. Advice and support State PSUs on restructuring or privatization or closure as decided by the Government.

(c) Tenure

The tenure of OSRFS is up to 31.03.2024 and may be continued, if Government of Odisha so desires.

4.3 Financial Assistance to State Public & Cooperative Enterprises to implement their Voluntary Retirement Scheme

Rightsizing of the workforce in State Public Enterprises is a key initiative for restructuring of the State's Public Sector Enterprises. This has helped to reduce the manpower cost with Voluntary Retirement of the employees. The **Voluntary Retirement Scheme (VRS)** of the Government of Odisha for public sector employees is administered by the concerned PSUs for which financial assistance is provided by the Department of Public Enterprises as per the **Voluntary Retirement Scheme (VRS)**.

4.4 Technical support and assistance to Public Enterprises:

OSRFS provided technical assistance and support on various policy initiatives to DPE and reform interventions to state PSUs as detailed below;

- Assistance to PSUs and Administrative Departments in preparation and signing of MOU for performance monitoring of State PSUs..
- Assist in development of policy guidelines for investment of surplus funds by state PSUs.
- Develop concept notes on Campus recruitment, instituting awards for best performing PSUs, Permanent Arbitration mechanism for resolution of commercial disputes among PSUs and with Administrative Departments.
- Assisted PSUs in study of business process and process reengineering for computerization of accounting and inventory management system along with estimation of hardware and software requirements.
- Conduct workshop for top management of state PSUs to sensitize on capability of MIS system in a computerized environment and advantage in decision making process.
- Assisted in restructuring of organization structure and manpower planning based on business requirements of the State PSUs.
- PSUs with social mandate are studied along with their development of business optimization plan to improve operational and financial sustainability.
- Strategic business planning of the PSUs through medium term business plan.

- v) Should have adequate internal resources to meet the additional financial burden arising out of the enhanced dose of D.A. from its own sources.
- vi) Signing of MOU with the Administrative Department for FY 2022-23.

The PSUs which fulfill the above criteria and have been categorized under the categorization framework will send their proposals to their respective Administrative Departments with due approval of their Board of Directors for necessary approval.

Other PSUs which are not coming under the categorization criteria will send their proposals to the Public Enterprises Department through their Administrative Departments after due approval of their Board of Directors for necessary consideration on case to case basis for release of enhanced D.A.
